

Just to keep you updated post ESHRE on what is happening with the Molecular Biometrics Viometrics-E in terms of when we can expect to be launching into Europe.

As we mentioned at the training day at ESHRE, we are currently finishing off the clinical testing in the UK, Japan and Australia, which should be finished sometime in September (a few weeks behind schedule).

One of the main points of these final clinical tests is to see if anything needs to be changed to the interface and protocol of using the system, to make it easier for the embryologists to carry out their work.

The results of these tests will therefore determine if there is a bit more work needed to be done from the design point of view, which may require a price change.

Therefore at the moment, we are still not ready to release pricing for this equipment, although as soon as we do have this information we will sent it on immediately.

We are still aiming for a January 2010 release in Europe, but this may be delayed slightly if the results of the tests require final changes to be made to the product or procedures.
